The Journal publishes original research articles, short communications and review articles, Systematic review articles, Meta-analysis review articles, and Case Report/Case series in the following areas:

- · Clinical nutrition and dietetics.
- Food service therapy.
- · Community nutrition.
- · Public health nutrition.

- · Nutrition practice and legal issues.
- · Food science and nutrition.
- Multidisciplinary research related to the above areas.

## **REVIEWERS' REQUIREMENTS**

## 1. Senior Reviewers qualification

- They must be registered and licensed by the Kenya Nutritionists and Dieticians Institute or a relevant professional body in their country.
- They Must hold a PhD and at least five years of post-doctoral experience in their chosen field.
- iii. They should have published at least ten publications in Nutrition and Dietetics in their chosen area of specialization.
- iv. The journal editorial team must complete peer review training.

### 2. Junior Reviewers qualification

- They must be Registered and Licensed with the Kenya Nutritionists and Dieticians Institute or a relevant professional body or equivalent in their country.
- ii. They Must hold a PhD and have graduated within 3 years.
- iii. They should have published at least three publications in Nutrition and Dietetics in their chosen area of specialization.
- iv. Must complete a peer review training by the Editor-In-Chief and the Editorial Board.

#### REVIEWERS OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assess the scientific quality of the manuscript with their expert knowledge.
- Prepare comprehensive and detailed review reports and remain responsive throughout the peer review process.
- Uphold the highest standards of professionalism and ethics, avoiding personal, financial, or intellectual biases, focusing solely on the research quality and written presentation of the manuscript.
- 4) To preserve confidentiality throughout the review process and not disclose or use

- unpublished information or communicate the manuscript content without prior consent from the Journal of Nutrition and Dietetics Editorial Team.
- Reviewers are requested to update their affiliation on their reviewer account to allow editors to identify potential conflicts of interest promptly.
- 6) To complete the review process by providing the reviewer's comments within 14 days.
